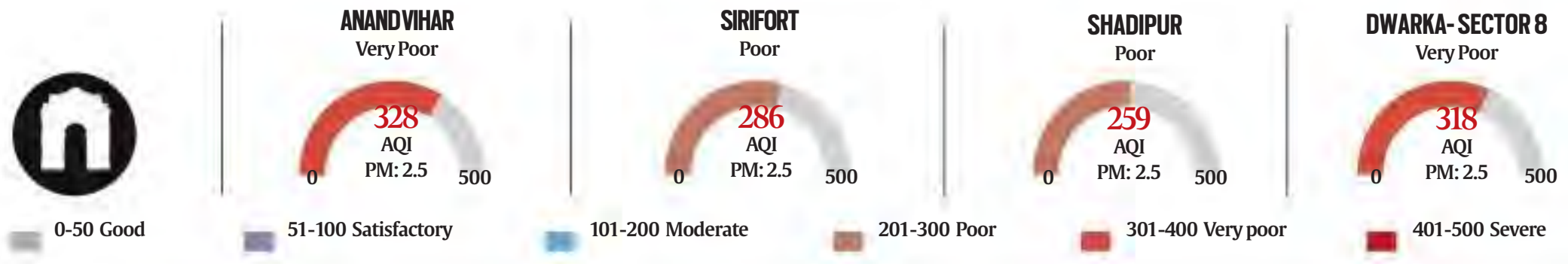

'11,000 HOTSPOTS WILL COVER ENTIRE CITY IN NEXT 6 MONTHS'

100 WiFi hotspots from Dec 16 as Delhi govt project finally gains signal strength

THE FIRST batch of 100 public WiFi hotspots, where people will be able to access internet for free, will be activated in Delhi on December 16, Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal said Wednesday, announcing that the entire city will be covered by 11,000 hotspots within the next six months. Kejriwal said that with the announcement, his government has "fulfilled all key poll promises" that the AAP made while canvassing for votes during the 2015 state assembly elections. With the tenure of the sixth assembly drawing to an end, Delhi goes to polls in another two months.

"WiFi was one of our key promises. In this digital age, minimum data usage is one of the basic necessities of a person. Like we treat water and power as basic lifelines, we are also going to make internet usage free. And with this we are fulfilling one of our last pending poll promises," the CM told a press conference.

Under the approved project, 11,000 hotspots will be put up across public places in Delhi, including 4,000 in bus shelters. Each hotspot will cover a radius of 100 metres and up to 200

people will be able to simultaneously access the internet at such points.

"In a way, in Delhi there will be one hotspot every 500 metres. The speed will be around 200 MBPS in high-density areas and 80 MBPS in low density areas. The data cap on every individual will be 1.5 GB per day and 15 GB per month," Kejriwal said.

For people, accessing the free WiFi would involve two taps on their smartphones. On selecting the network name and entering the mobile number, one will receive an OTP (one time password), which will be the gateway to free internet usage.

The project, which will cost the Delhi government around Rs 100 crore annually, is being executed by a private firm, Presto Infosolutions Pvt Ltd, which will be paid by the government on a per hotspot basis, as reported by *The Indian Express* on November 14.

"The installation of hotspots has started. On December 16, 100 hotspots will be activated. Subsequently, every week 500 hotspots will be commissioned. The project will be completed within six months," Kejriwal said, flanked by PWD Minister Satyendar Jain, whose department is overseeing the implementation.

JNU case: HC refuses to direct Delhi govt on prosecution sanction

THE DELHI High Court Wednesday refused to direct the Delhi government to grant approval for prosecution of former JNU students' union president Kanhaiya Kumar and others in the 2016 JNU sedition case, observing that the issue of grant of sanction against individuals has to be decided in accordance with the law. "The respondent (Delhi government) will decide grant of sanction or otherwise in accordance with the law applicable to the facts of that case," a bench of Chief Justice DN Patel and Justice C Hari Shankar said.

On October 25, the Delhi government's prosecution department had informed a Delhi court hearing the JNU sedition case that the decision on whether or not to accord sanction for prosecution is still pending for approval before the ministry concerned.

The trial court had fixed the matter for further hearing on December 11, and had sought the presence of the investigating officer in the case.

The High Court bench noted that the petitioner, former BJP MLA Nand Kishor Garg, seemed to have "personal interest" in the FIR registered against Kumar and others in the 2016 sedition case.

Garg, through his counsel Shashank Deo Sudhi, submitted that the Delhi government has

"evidently failed to grant the sanction letter", which is not in accordance with the statutory obligations.

Apart from seeking a direction to the Delhi government for the grant of sanction, the plea had also sought issuance of guidelines for expeditious prosecution on all sensitive criminal and corruption related cases.

The HC turned down the demand and observed that there were enough meticulous laws in place with respect to grant of sanction by the state government.

The bench also refused to give direction for constitution of a high-powered committee to look into the alleged delay in grant of sanction. Saying that the "government has got adequate number of officers, there is no need of a super committee", the bench disposed of the petition.

According to official records, police had applied to the Delhi government for sanction just two hours before filing the chargesheet on January 14.

The court has been deferring taking cognizance of the chargesheet against the accused in the absence of a prosecution sanction.

5 held for abducting, killing GK businessman

FIVE MEN, including a father-son duo, have been arrested for allegedly abducting a 64-year-old businessman from outside his home in South Delhi's Greater Kailash, strangulating him and dumping his body in Madhya Pradesh's Jhansi.

According to police, Arun Kumar Sharma had been abducted on November 15, and an FIR was registered based on a

complaint by Sharma's sister Shashi Kiran a day later.

The case was later transferred to the anti-human trafficking unit (AHTU) of the Crime Branch, which made the arrests. The body is yet to be recovered.

"In her complaint, Shashi alleged Arun left home in the morning to attend a court hearing in a property dispute case in Gurgaon. He was supposed to meet his advocate at MG Road," a senior officer said.

According to the officer, Shashi alleged that Sharma was

embroiled in a property dispute with one Rishi Raj Chauhan. "In 2009, Sharma purchased a property worth Rs 3.5 crore in Gurgaon from Chauhan. Since then, a dispute had been going on. Sharma secured an order from the Supreme Court in the case and was going to attend the hearing on November 15 at the Gurgaon court," the officer said.

AHTU found that Chauhan allegedly hired three contract killers to get rid of Sharma.

"They strangled him inside their car, which had a fake num-

ber plate. They then left for Jhansi and dumped his body in a canal. Chauhan and his son have been arrested as well," the officer said.

As per the officer, local police had questioned Chauhan after Shashi pointed to his involvement. However, the probe could not move further, and the case was transferred to AHTU. "Police arrested the father and son after tracing their conversation with an accused," the officer said.

Sharma lived with his sister and daughter in GK-I. His wife died around two years ago.

Ghaziabad deaths: Writing on wall leads to relative's arrest for 'abetment'

A DAY after five deaths rocked a Ghaziabad residential society, a relative of the family has been arrested for alleged abetment, with police saying his name was mentioned in a suicide note left behind on a wall.

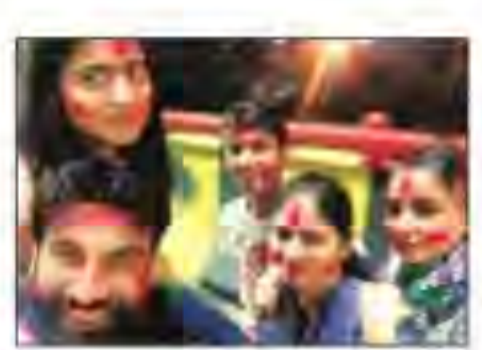
On Tuesday morning, Gulshan Vasudeva (45), his wife Parveena (43), and Sanjana (38), who moved in with them around two years ago, jumped to their death from their eighth-floor apartment at Krishna Apra Sapphire residential complex, between 4.30 and 5 am. The couple's children Rithik (13) and Kritika (18) were found dead in their beds, with police suspecting Gulshan smothered and stabbed them in their sleep.

In a note scribbled on the wall, Gulshan named Parveena's relative Rakesh Verma, who he claimed had duped him in 2015. "After questioning several family members, it was found that Rakesh made Gulshan invest roughly Rs 1.5 crore in a property with the promise of high returns. But only a part of the money was returned, and Gulshan eventually owed several people a large sum. This allegedly drove him to depression," said Sudhir Kumar Singh, SSP, Ghaziabad.

Police said Rakesh, a property dealer, allegedly got Gulshan to register the property in the name of a friend. The 200-square metre plot was fraudulently transferred to a third person, and Rakesh allegedly stood to benefit from the deal, police said.

Businessmen in Gandhi Nagar's Guru Nanak lane, where Gulshan ran a jeans manufacturing and retail business out of a four-storey property, suspected there was another, more immediate reason for his problems: Six months ago, he started business with a Kolkata-based firm.

According to them, Gulshan



was excited about the prospect of exporting material worth lakhs, and the firm promised to make payments within 90 days. Slowly, the payments began piling up.

Arun Bhatia, a businessman and Gulshan's friend, said: "He gave them goods worth Rs 90 lakh, expecting returns in time. But the payments were delayed. During Eid, the labourers demanded money and wages and he had to borrow to pay them as well. The financial transactions with that firm had a far-reaching impact on him since he didn't have money for daily operations."

In September, Gulshan requested Bhatia to purchase 100 pieces worth Rs 35,000 from him since he needed cash. Later, Gulshan again asked if Bhatia could purchase 3,000 more pieces. "Due to slowdown, it was impossible for me to raise so much cash," said Bhatia.

According to police, on Monday evening, Gulshan is believed to have received more bad news from the Kolkata-based firm. After allegedly killing his children early, Gulshan made a video call to Ramesh Arora, his neighbour and friend. "He made a video call at 3.38 am and showed me his dead children. He kept saying everything was over and mentioned the message from the firm. Even earlier, he would tell me he was in debt, and I would tell him everything would be okay. During the call, I asked him to calm down but he hung up. I then called his brother, but it was too late," Arora said.



Family claims Sanjana and Gulshan had court marriage, police probe

IN A suicide note he left behind on the wall, Gulshan Vasudeva wrote that he wanted him, his wife, their two children and another woman, Sanjana, to be cremated together. On Wednesday afternoon, while the bodies of the family members were cremated close to Hindon river, Sanjana's body was buried in Rampura.

According to her family, Sanjana, the youngest of eight siblings, converted to Hinduism a year and a half ago so she could marry Gulshan.

While her family claims she married Gulshan in a local court, police are yet to verify the claim. "So far we have not recovered any document that shows Gulshan and Sanjana were married. We are investigating further," said Sudhir Kumar Singh, SSP Ghaziabad.

"She studied till class VIII and was glad when Gulshan offered

3. The Central Transmission Utility has recommended for grant of transmission licence to the applicant to establish the proposed transmission system.

4. Based on material available on record, the Commission vide order dated 26.11.2019 in Petition No. 303/TL/2019, has proposed to issue transmission licence to the applicant for establishing the transmission system as noted in para 1 above.

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of clause (a) of sub-section (5) of Section 15 of the Act that suggestions or objections, if any, to the Commission's proposal to grant transmission licence to the applicant, as aforesaid, be sent to the undersigned by 13.12.2019 at the above noted address. The suggestions or objections received after the specified date shall not be considered.

7. The application shall be taken up for further hearing by the Commission on 17.12.2019. Any person who files suggestions or objections may in his/her discretion attend the hearing, for which no TA/DA shall be paid by the Commission.
